1. Selection of Federal Initiatives

Recommendation for Federal Initiatives for FY 2012 (order of priority):

- #3 Combine Green Parking Lots and Energy Savings through Green Building Research (FY 2011) (Dr. Hal Langford will contact PIs for revised proposal.)
- #4 Dissemination of Injury Prevention Program for Independently Living Older Adults in rural communities (Dr. Brent Mangus will contact PIs.)

2. Course Evaluation for HB 2504 Compliance

Increase Grants: 10% a year for 5 years

Increase Grant Funding: 10% a year for 5 years
