# 11.99.99.R0.22 Undergraduate Seniors Taking Graduate Courses for Credit

## **Procedure Summary**

The Graduate Council establishes basic standards for undergraduate seniors taking graduate courses for credit at Texas A&M University-Commerce.

This procedure documents the requirements for undergraduate seniors taking graduate courses for credit.

### **Procedures and Responsibilities**

- 1 A last semester senior who lacks 12 hours, or fewer, to graduate and has an overall undergraduate grade point average of 3.00 or higher may enroll for 3 to 6 hours of graduate credit. The student must submit a request and gain approval from the student's undergraduate advisor, Department Head offering the course, and the Dean of the Graduate School prior to enrolling in the course.
- 2 Graduate courses cannot apply toward an undergraduate degree, except in an approved accelerated program.
- 3 The maximum load for seniors who register for graduate credit is 15 hours per long semester or 6 hours per summer term, including credit for graduate courses.
