On September 25, 2013, SACSCOC accepted notification that Texas A&M University-Commerce had programs which had not been formally closed out, either because of consolidation into other existing programs or due to low-producing numbers as was required by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.

Teach-out plans were not required for the program consolidations or closures with zero enrollment, since students had already completed the programs. However, in keeping with the Commission's guidance, we are now submitting teach-out plans for the programs in which students are still enrolled. We appreciate your understanding as we move forward by continuing to address prior issues such as these.
