Audition Material

Woodwind and Brass

- 1. Scales
 - The panel will choose up to three full-range scales
 - Scales should be performed in sixteenth notes at Quarter Note = 92-104
 - A full-range chromatic scale may also be requested
- 2. Prepared Excerpts
 - Audition excerpts will be available for **download on July 1**st from the Department of Music website under the current student resources tab.
 - You will be sent an e-mail with the information for your instrument and download instructions
- 3. Sight-reading
 - There will be a short sight-reading excerpt. For practice during the Summer, we recommend that

you make use of www.sightreadingfactory.com or similar option.

Percussion

- 1. Performance excerpt on Snare Drum
 - The audition excerpt will be available for **in late July** on the Department of Music website
 - You will also be sent an e-mail with the information by Dr. Zator
- 2. Sight-reading
 - There will be a short sight-reading excerpt on marimba and timpani.
