 - Someone teaching a graduate course needs a Ph.D. in the discipline or special qualifications (need letter in faculty file that explains the special qualifications).

7) \$10,000 degree initiative: Dual Credit on Steroids (Grady and Hal Langford's idea)

• Hire faculty in junior colleges to teach our classes for our credit, but students would pay junior college tuition and get a \$10,000 degree.

Competency-based model, SxSW EDU presentation on March 6th (Brent Mangus and Rusty Waller's idea)

- Learning Outcomes translated to class credit
- Move developmental mathematics to *Mastery-based*
 - Modular
 - Independent of semester format
- Ramping up the level of description
- Ramping up *certificate programs*. What do you offer?
- Dan Jones will be on a panel with the Chancellor and a couple other people at the March 6th South by Southwest Music Festival in Austin.
- They will discuss the 21st century higher education.

8) New TAMUS Policy 11.09 states:

"The coordinating board conducts an annual review of degree programs at institutions of higher education to determine which are low-producing degree programs because they do not meet minimum standards for the number of degrees awarded.

Academic institutions will prepare a report of the coordinating board's review to the chancellor and board. The report will include supporting documentation for requests to consolidate degree programs and temporary exemptions"

- The System wants to know about low producing programs before the Coordinating Board.

10) Comments from this week's ADC:

Issues with foreign students *traveling* during the semester.

- Looking for consistency in foreign students being here when classes begin in August.
- If not, then you need to handle it.

- Talked about John Mark Jones requiring foreign students to sign a waiver that says:
 - 1) You do not have a letter from your faculty or college acknowledging the reason you are leaving.
 - 2) You are taking a risk that you may not get back in the country or if you fail a class it will cause visa problems.
 - 3) They still may leave, but at least now they have to sign a form that they understand they are doing it at their own risk.

Lemanski says Promotion/Tenure policy needs overhaul. Advising concerns from SGA (CoSEA to go on-line).

- The Provost stated that a good tenure and promotion policy needs to be about three pages.
- Revising the policy would be a great opportunity for a faculty member to earn points toward their service.
- I think we will continue to see improvements.

11) Summer and fall schedule sharing:

- - Department chairs were given a copy of each department's summer and fall schedule. The department chairs looked at each other's schedules to work out any conflicts.

 - Will talk to you individually to get a guess on enrollment in the classes.

12) Other Business (Grady)

- Just hired Karen St. John to fill Carley Tucker's (academic advisor) position.
- She will start on Monday.
- Her title is Academic Advising and Outreach.
- Going to lean on her to push our advising functions out on the web.
- Want to get student records in the student's hands.
- The two year schedules will go in to her database that she will be pushing out to students.
- Will take a while for her to get the database loaded.
- The students will have access to their degree plan, able to log on from their mobile or a web portal to review their records.
- This will give us a lot more coherent communication with the students.
- Right now we don't have any support for faculty in the advising role.
- Karen will also support the faculty.
- Trying to set her up as a resource person.

(Grady) Roseann's Form:

- This is a dramatic improvement.
- It will fit front and back on one piece of paper.
- We need to get them filled out and turned in.

(Eileen Faulkenberry) Heard that Graduate School will pay for STEM graduate courses this summer?

- Graduate School is going to do two things:
 1). Any new graduate student will get the first class free.
 2). If you take two classes, you get the third one free.
 You get two classes for the price of one.
 This is only in certain disciplines.
