## Appendix C-1

### TEACHING AND EDUCATION EXPERIENCE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

#### Narrative Statement Vaughan

I have a lengthy history of teaching in both Associate Degree and Baccalaureate nursing programs. In the past, I have worked on several inter-professional education (IPE) programs including a ventilator workshop for emergency department nurses, co-taught with a certified respiratory therapist. In addition, I have been involved in several IPE instructor situations for the American Heart Association with regard to ACLS IPEs and PALS IPEs. I completed my final course NURS 6621 Practicum for my DNP which has also emphasized IPE heavily throughout the curriculum.

In 2021 I completed all DNP course work and graduated August 18, 2021. The formal DNP course work has included leadership training, TEAM STEPPS, change theory, and innovation to translate evidence into best practices to care for vulnerable populations. There was a strong influence in population health and equity which align with the 2030 FON report theme of “Charting a path toward health equity.” I was hired by LSU in May 2021 as an Instructor in Nursing. In Summer 2021, I completed LSU orientation under Colette Baudoin as a mentor for NURS 3351 Adult Health. During Fall 2021, I co-taught NURS 2417 Intro to Professional Nursing as my secondary course. My primary courses were NURS 3351 Adult Health, as well as NURS 3362 Clinicals and NURS 3372 Simulation and Lab. During Spring 2022, I taught the same Adult Health primary courses. My secondary course has been HLSC 2314 Health Assessment lab. I have also served as faculty advisor for over 50 students. In addition, I graded as a part of TEAMUp for Interprofessional teamwork for LSU Health New Orleans.

Learning is a lifelong process. I have completed numerous professional development programs to enhance active learning to prepare our students for the NEXTGEN NCLEX. Much of this course work involves how to instruct and enhance students’ abilities to recognize cues in patients in order to develop clinical judgment skills. This importantly takes critical thinking and evidence-based practice to a new level while preparing students for future health care challenges. As mentioned, I strongly believe that enhancing student diversity and addressing the social determinants of health both clinically and in the classroom benefits all nursing students.

In addition, in 2022, I applied for and am being mentored in the LSU TigerTrax Mentoring program under the direction of Dr. Jennifer Manning. My goals are to enhance my abilities in the classroom through use of instructional technologies that will benefit our students. I also hope to enhance my organizational, teaching skills, and leadership in the undergraduate program of nursing here at LSU. In total, I have over 25 year of teaching experience in both Associate degree and Baccalaureate nursing programs.



## Appendix C-2

### RESEARCH AND SCHOLARSHIP

#### Narrative Statement Vaughan

Last year, in 2021, I completed my DNP project which looked at the under-representation of Latinx nursing students within the state of Texas. From that project, I was able to present both statewide and locally, including to the Texas Nurses Association Nurse Empowerment series and the University of Texas at Arlington by invitation. This important work took a strong look at reasons for lack of diversity, equity and inclusion within our nursing profession. Upon commencement of teaching for LSU, this project data was also used to look at Louisiana statistics for the same ethnicity. A previous president of NAHN asked me to spearhead the development of a Louisiana Chapter of Hispanic nurses, a project on which I am still working to complete with local Latinx nurses. The group has achieved base camp status with the NAHN and plans are to establish the chapter in 2022. I have also worked with Dr. Barrier on the establishment of an affinity group for Latinx nurses at LSU HSC New Orleans. I presented to the DEI student group during National Hispanic Heritage month. Issues relating to D,E, and I continue to be strong influences on my scholarship endeavors. I was originally published in the *Journal of Nursing Education* in 1991, the title of my article being “Is There Really Racism in Nursing?” My Master’s thesis was a screenplay depicting a story about a Black male nurse, *Angel of Mercy*. I also peer review for *Hispanic Healthcare International*.

Another scholarship area of interest of mine is resilience and grit as they related to nursing student success. I have researched and drafted a student success program modeled on the N.U.R.S.E stress reduction program piloted by the University of Cincinnati. This program builds resilience through active learning participation in several realistic simulations, as well as overall self-care. It is based on the Six Essentials of the Healthy Work Environment put forth by the American Association of Critical Care Nurses. Although this was originally slated to be launched in Texas, I am now seeking an opportunity to implement this program here at LSU HSC New Orleans in cooperation with the office of student success. At LSU, I actively participate in the Scholarly Roundtable discussion group. I was selected and scholarhipped to attend both the LSU Publication Workshop and the Grant Writing Workshop. In 2021, I served on a grant writing team for a HRSA grant on developing resilience in nurses.

This year, I will be published in a peer reviewed journal, *Critical Care Clinics of North America* on liver trauma. In addition, I was asked to serve as editor for a complete volume of *Critical Care Nursing Clinics* on

trauma, engaging with over 13 other authors from around the country, including one international. This will be my primary scholarship project for 2022, extending into 2023. In addition, I continue to write and publish a blog on independent publishing, <https://jeanettevaughan.wordpress.com> writing a feature column called *Belles of Steele* which focuses on the achievements of strong women who have changed their corner of the world. Publication of this work should be completed in early 2023. I have written and published five books involving aviation and military aviation history in the historical fiction genre. Several of my books were awarded medals by the Military Writers Society of America.

Service to my community has always been a strong part of my nursing career. During COVID, I served as a nurse for the Baylor Healthcare System COVID-19 vaccination clinic.
