I am the author of *Social Structure- Social Learning and Delinquency*, a book that presents the results of a test of Akers' Social Structure Social Learning (SSSL) theory on a sample of juveniles, suggesting that Akers' statement of social learning requires modification. Expanding on the theoretical implications of the SSSL research, I tested a revised social learning statement that emphasizes contingencies of reinforcement on a dataset typically used to launch or support life-course arguments.
