



Attaching a Rubric to New Assignment

This handout is for attaching an <u>existing</u> rubric to a <u>new</u> Assignment. The same process can be used to attach an existing rubric to a new discussion, by selecting "Discussion" instead of Assignment. 
1. Create the assignment you want to associate an existing rubric with by clicking on "Activities" on the Navigation bar and then selecting assignments.



2. Click on the "New Assignment" button.



3. Make sure you are on the "**Properties**" tab for your assignment and begin to fill in the assignment specifics.



4. When you get to the "**Evaluation and Feedback**" heading, click on the "**Add Rubric**" button.
