#### **University Leadership**

#### John Sharp, M.P.A. Chancellor, The Texas A&M University System

John Sharp was appointed chancellor of The Texas A&M University System by the Board of Regents on September 6, 2011. As chancellor, Sharp leads one of the nation's largest university systems, which has an annual budget of \$7.2 billion. Enrollment at the A&M System's 11 universities and health science center has grown to more than 152,000, and externally funded research expenditures are in excess of \$1 billion.

Sharp brings with him more than three decades of public service. He came to the A&M System from Ryan & Company, where he was a principal with the largest state and local tax consulting firm of its kind in Texas. He earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in political science from Texas A&M University in



1972, where he was a member of the Corps staff of the Corps of Cadets and was elected student body president. Upon graduation, he was commissioned as a second lieutenant in the United States Army Reserves. He belongs to American Legion.

In 1976, Sharp received a master's degree in public administration from Southwest Texas State University while working full-time with the Legislative Budget Board in Austin. In 1978, he opened a one-man real estate firm in Victoria, Texas, and became a successful small business owner.

That same year he was elected to the Texas House of Representatives and was named "Outstanding Freshman" by Texas Monthly. He won a seat in the Texas Senate in 1982, where he served on the powerful Senate Finance Committee, and was elected to the Texas Railroad Commission in 1986.


Sharp was elected state comptroller in 1990 and re-elected in 1994. When he took office, he quickly began working to fulfill his pledge to "make government work more like our most successful businesses." Eight years later, he reinvented Texas state government and turned it into a high-quality, low-cost customer service operation that has saved taxpayers billions, helped avert a state income tax and served as a model around the world.

# Mark Rudin, Ph.D. President, Texas A&M University-Commerce

Dr. Mark Rudin was appointed President of Texas A&M University-Commerce by The Texas A&M University System Board of Regents on August 16, 2018. Dr. Rudin has a Bachelor of General Health Science (1983), Master of Science in Health Physics (1985), and Doctor of Philosophy in Medicinal Chemistry with a Concentration in Health Physics (1989) from Purdue University.

Student success, expanded research, and economic development are among Dr. Rudin's top priorities as President. His vision for A&M-Commerce includes adapting traditional models to meet the needs of all students and providing skills development in preparation for post-graduation employment.

Prior to assuming the presidency at A&M-Commerce, Dr. Rudin served as the Vice President for Research and Economic Development at Boise State University.



Dr. Rudin previously served at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas in a variety of administrative roles before being named Interim Vice President for Research and Graduate Dean. He also served as a Technical/Administrative Assistant with the U.S. Department of Energy and as a Senior Program Specialist/Project Engineer with EG&G Idaho, Inc. Dr. Rudin's career in education began in Idaho where he served as an instructor in the Department of Health Physics at Idaho State University.

#### Jamie Wilson, Ph.D. Superintendent, Denton ISD

Dr. Jamie Wilson enters his 31st year of service in public school education with 17 years of service in Denton ISD. Named superintendent of schools for the district in July 2012, Dr. Wilson's life-long ties to the Denton community positioned him to become the leader of the school system.

Dr. Wilson has built an impeccable reputation throughout the state of Texas for his public education advocacy, growth management, and instructional innovation.

During Dr. Wilson's tenure, the district has experienced accelerated growth building six secondary campuses and nine elementary schools, with 12 of those schools opening in just the past eleven years.

Dr. Wilson has received numerous accolades and recognition for his leadership. He was the only superintendent from Texas to be named to the "Top 25 Superintendents to Watch" list by the National School Public Relations Association (NSPRA) in 2016.

In 2017, he was named "Tech-Savvy Superintendent" by the Texas K12 CTO Council for promoting and supporting innovative uses of technology in Denton ISD.

In 2020, Dr. Wilson was named Region 11's Superintendent of the Year and one of five finalists for the Superintendent of the Year award for the State of Texas.

Dr. Wilson received his bachelor's and master's degree from the University of North Texas and earned his superintendency certification from Texas Woman's University.

He is married to a former educator, Melanie Pettit Wilson. They have two daughters, Makenzie and Macie. Makenzie is currently a third-grade teacher in Lewisville ISD, and Macie is a recent graduate of Texas Tech University in Lubbock.
