Thank you for your letter of January 24, 2012, notifying the Commission on Colleges that Texas A&M University-Commerce will establish, effective fall 2012, a Multi-Institutional Teaching Center to be located on the Midlothian campus (899 Mt. Zion Road, Midlothian, TX 76065) of Navarro College, in partnership with Texas A&M University-Commerce, Tarleton State University, and Navarro College. The Navarro College Partnership (Navarro and A&M-Commerce) was established in 1999, and the expanded partnership will capitalize on the resources of multiple institutions of higher education.

Texas A&M-Commerce is approved to offer 25-49% of the credits required for the Bachelor of Science in Interdisciplinary Studies degree at Midlothian. Other programs for the Center would be phased in to meet needs.
