- UEC Update
  - Accountability Report placed TAMUC third now after Tarleton
    - Possibly due to Tarleton's building of a campus in Ft. Worth rather than renting
  - Senate/House Bills
    - Senate Bill 1
      - \$107.8 billion budget
      - 27% reduction
      - Equates to a reduction of \$1.2 million/year at TAMUC
      - There will be a fading-out of special items (i.e. TAB, Industrial Engineering, etc.)
    - Both Senate bills 557 and 552 passed
    - House Bill 3366 did not pass
    - Also covered, beginning September 1<sup>st</sup>, no texting in the state of Texas while driving
  - Campus Operation Tours
  - Blue algae was growing in Gee Lake
    - Only harmful to fish, not the other animals
    - Signs and awareness being made about not feeding the ducks bread/bread-like products
  - A risk assessment must be done for any student traveling on a chaperoned trip beyond a 25 mile radius
  - New football initiative
    - One free ticket for all staff/faculty, with the option to receive up to four more while proceeds last
