



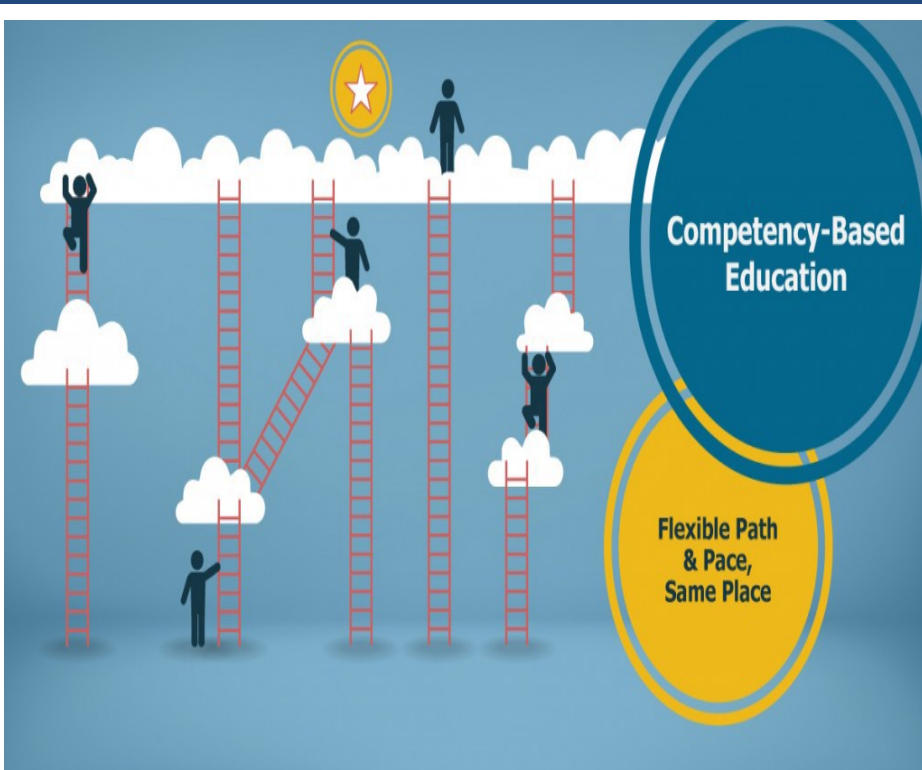

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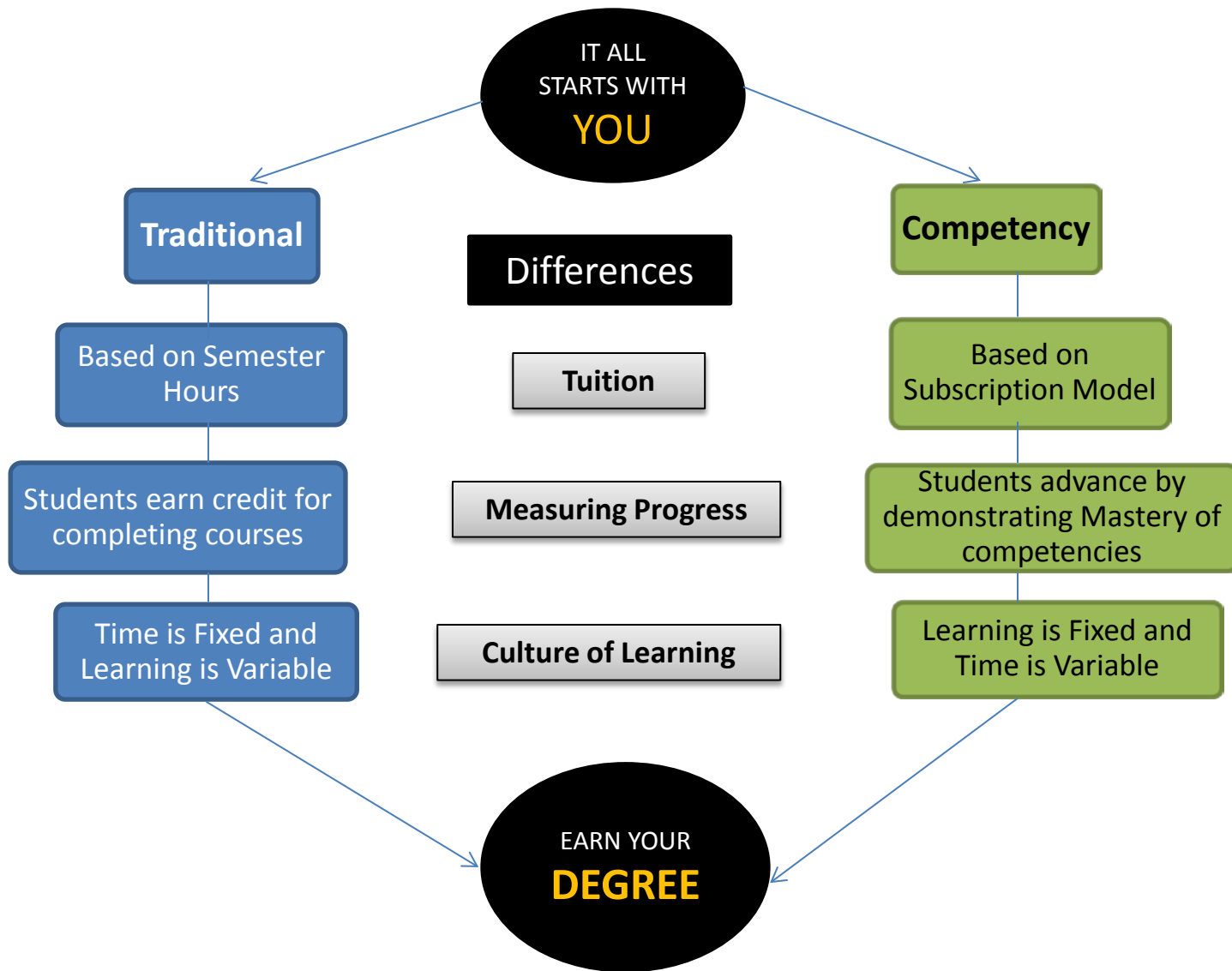
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What is Competency-Based Education?



Competency-Based Education is the Transition away from the Traditional seat time, in favor of a structure that creates flexibility, and allows students to progress as they demonstrate mastery of academic content, regardless of time, place, or pace of learning. (USDE)

Organizational Leadership Program Overview

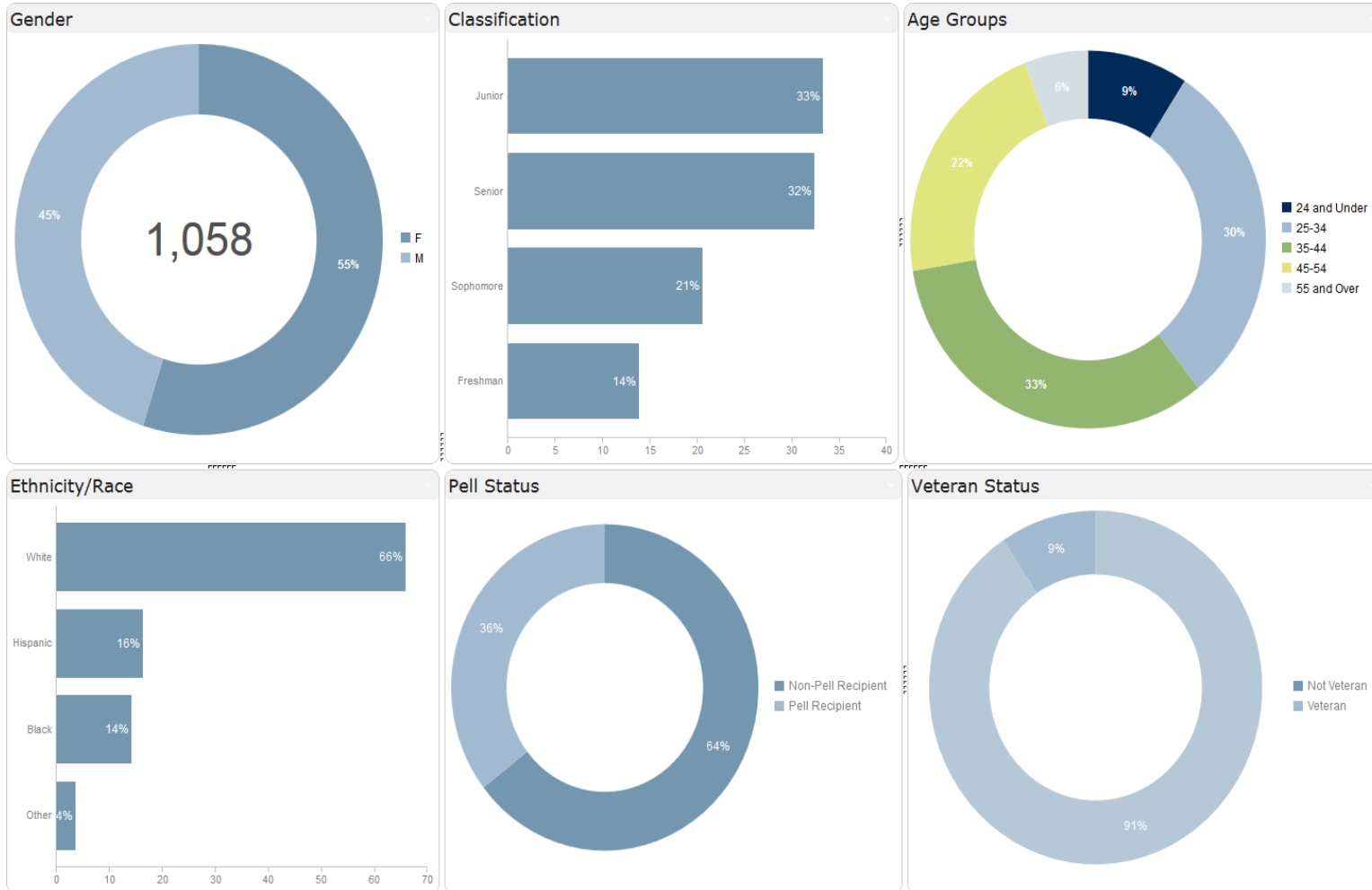
- B.A.A.S in Organizational Leadership
- 99 competencies- 91 lower and 8 upper division
- Competencies mapped back to courses and 120 SCH total
- Competencies defined by faculty and industry
- State's first SACSCOC approved competency-based degree offered by a public university
- Launched Spring 2014
- Delivered 100% online
- Students are supported by instructors and academic success coach

SUBSCRIPTION MODEL DELIVERY



Program delivered via a subscription model with students attempting as many competencies as possible in each seven week term for the same flat rate of \$750

STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS



- Chart shows our TAB students are Non-traditional students/Adult learners who have earned credit hours but have no degree to show for it.
- CBE a viable option for them to complete their degrees as it allows them to study at their own pace.

AVERAGE ESTIMATED TUITION COST TO DEGREE COMPLETION

Last 60 hours of 120 SCH Program- Completed in Two Years

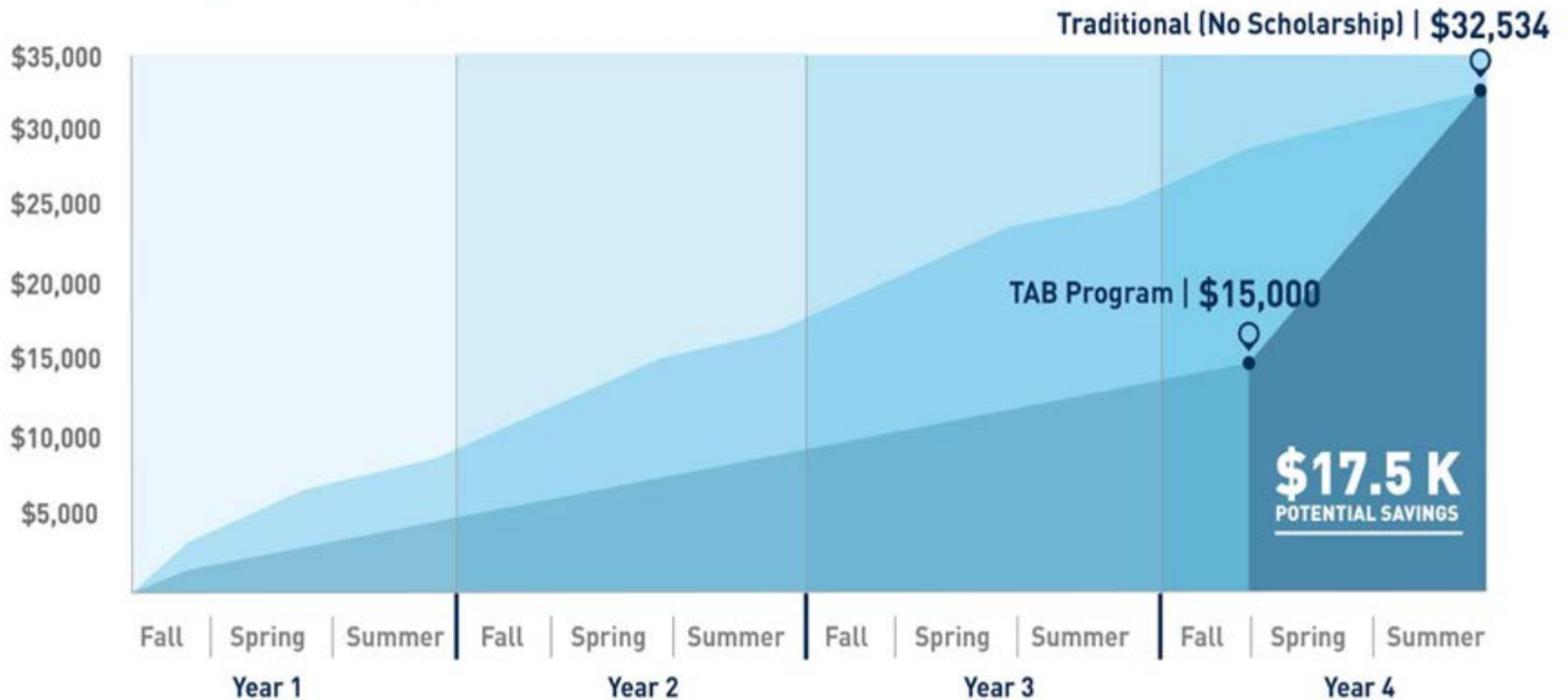
- Traditional (No Scholarship)

- TAB-ORGL students save up to 33 percent more in comparison to students in the general transfer population who received a top-tier transfer scholarship at A&M-Commerce

AVERAGE ESTIMATED TUITION COST TO DEGREE COMPLETION

120 SCH Program - Completed in Four Years or Less



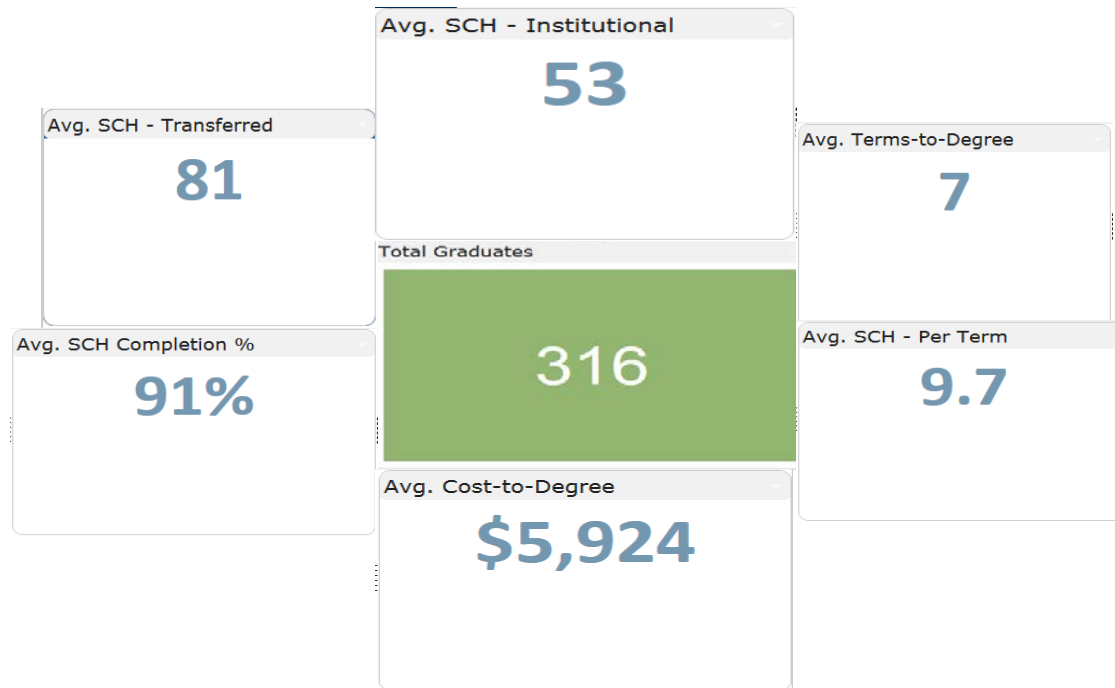
- TAB-ORGL students can save up to 53% more to complete their degrees in comparison to traditional programs

ESTIMATED COST SAVINGS FOR TAB-ORGL STUDENTS

ESTIMATED COST SAVINGS FOR TAB STUDENT	Average Texas Public University Tuition and Fees	Texas Affordable Baccalaureate Program	COST SAVING TO STUDENT
Cost per credit hour	\$266	\$125	\$141
Annual Cost	\$7,986	\$4,500	\$3,486
Cost for 120 hour Degree	\$31,944	\$15,000	\$16,944

- TAB-ORGL student could complete a bachelor's degree for around half the cost of a traditional program.

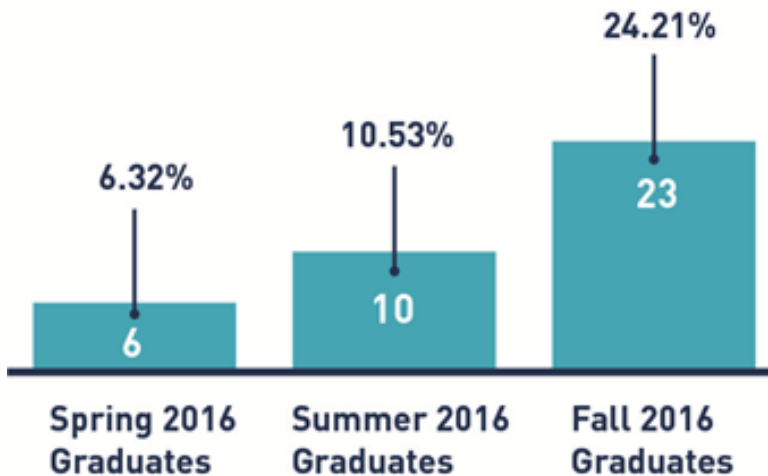


Graduates of our CBE TAB-ORGL program, transforming high amounts of accumulated debt into degrees for under \$6,000 at TAMUC

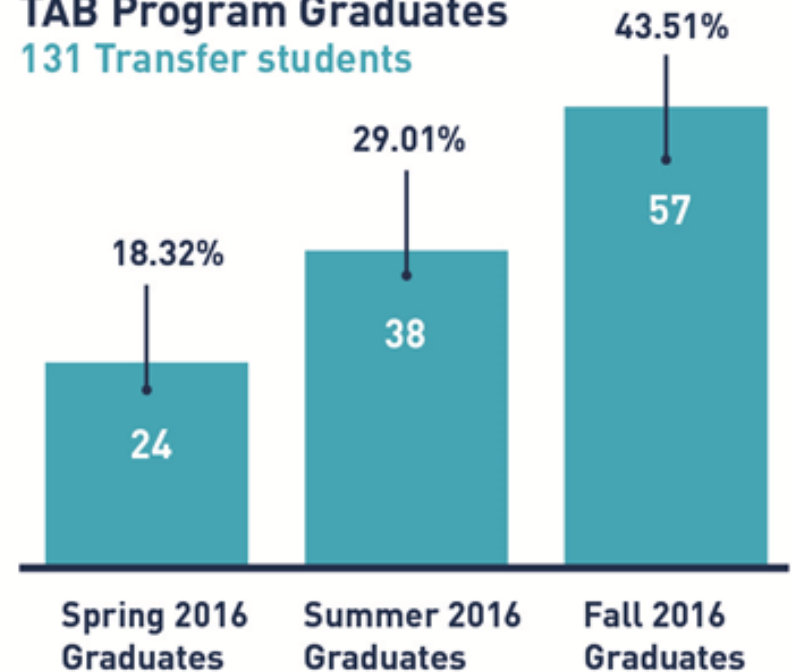
ACCELERATED TIME TO COMPLETION

Traditional BAAS Graduates 95 Transfer students

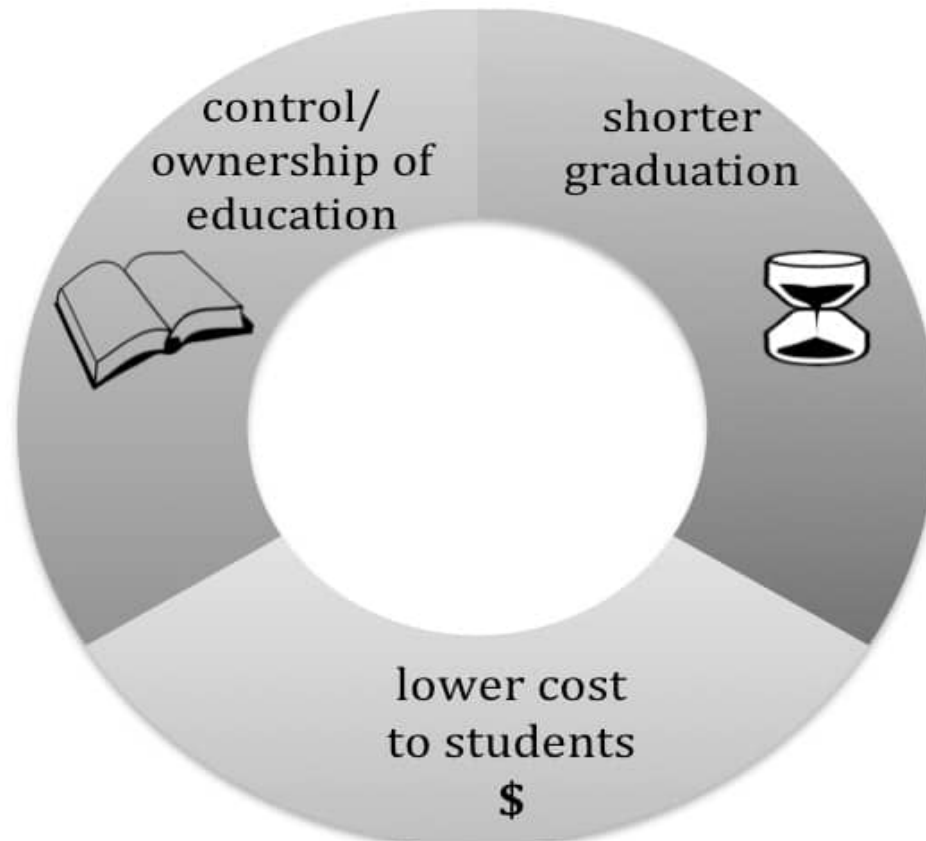


TAB Program Graduates 131 Transfer students



- Accelerated time-to-completion of 19.3% percentage points faster for the TAB-ORGL cohort.

CONCLUSION



- Over 3 million post-traditional, working students with some college credit and no degree in Texas
- Competency-Based Education an effective Pathway to Earn their Degrees
