Research Agenda

I am interested in general explanations for juvenile and adult deviant behavior, as well as causes and correlates of police behavior. I am the author of *Social Structure- Social Learning and Delinquency*, a book that presents the results of a test of Akers' Social Structure Social Learning (SSSL) theory on a sample of juveniles, suggesting that Akers' statement of social learning requires modification. Expanding on the theoretical implications of the SSSL research, I tested a revised social learning statement that emphasizes contingencies of reinforcement on a dataset typically used to launch or support life-course arguments. Also notable, I have compiled population, social, economic, crime, and crime-control data for U.S. cities and towns (places) with a population of 10,000 or greater ($N=2113$) for the decades 1970s, 1980s, 1990s, and 2000s. This comprehensive yet expandable dataset allows continuing examinations of crime and crime-control from multiple theoretical perspectives.
