**(aka Advanced Placement Program®)**

## **What is the AP Program?**

The College Board's® Advanced Placement Program® (AP) enables students to pursue college-level studies while still in high school. More than thirty exams in multiple subject areas are offered. *(See back of this flyer for complete list of exams offered for credit at Texas A&M – Commerce).* AP exams are given nationally at designated high schools during the month of May. AP exams are graded on a scale of 0-5. A score of 3 or higher is needed for credit.

## **How do I get involved with the AP Program?**

The AP Program is open to students at high schools with AP programs who are willing to accept the challenge of a rigorous curriculum.
