

REGISTRATION QUICK FACTS Summer/Fall 2020

Getting Started

- Register as soon as possible when registration opens
- Contact me for help choosing classes
- Do not take out-of-program courses without approval
- For step-by-step instructions on enrolling, please access our **MyLeo User Guide**
- You are required to accept our university's financial responsibility agreement details in guide
- If you are unable to complete registration for <u>any</u> reason, please contact your Graduate Enrollment Specialist

Course Load

- It is normally advised that graduate students take 6 hours (typically the equivalent of two classes) each semester in fall, spring, and summer (ideally one in Summer I and one in Summer II)
- It is not advised to exceed 6 hours unless you don't work
- 9 hours (typically the equivalent of three classes) is considered full time in fall/spring
- 6 hours total is full time in summer
- You do **NOT** have to be full time to receive financial aid at the graduate level see financial aid section

Drops/Withdrawals

- Consult with me *before* you drop/withdraw from courses after they begin to go over best options
- A drop is when you get out of one of your classes, but remain enrolled in at least one remaining course
- Withdrawing is when you get out of all of your classes
- If you're enrolled in one class and eliminate enrollment, that is a withdraw
- *Drops/Withdrawals affect financial aid see this LINK

DegreeWorks (it's important)

- Access DegreeWorks through MyLeo to ensure that all courses are counting in your degree plan
- If you see a course listed under non-program electives, contact your Graduate Enrollment Specialist
- Outside-of-program courses should be taken with the consultation of an advisor with a substitution made in your degree plan where necessary
- Do not take courses that do not count in your degree and try to have them approved later

Financial Aid

- Financial aid is available fall, spring, and summer
- Mini semesters do not qualify for financial aid
- Enroll when registration opens aid will disburse later
- Register in 6 hours or more to receive financial aid
- Apply for financial aid at this LINK
- Make sure to enter our school code 003565
- Information about applying can be found at this LINK
- Make sure to fill out the 2020-2021 app for the next academic year that begins in Fall 2020
- The 2019-2020 app is good through Summer II 2020
- Financial aid will *not* cover classes that do not count towards your degree
