Students will finish the AA/S with a minimum of 62 semester hours. DC sciences are 4 hours each. TAMUC sciences are 3 hours each. Students must complete a minimum of 60 hours at TAMUC.

**Students desiring the Bachelor of Arts in Human Services degree must complete 4 classes in one foreign language. Students with 2 high school credits in a foreign language need only complete 2 additional classes in that foreign language. Students desiring the Bachelor of Arts in Human Services may delete 1 elective listed below.*
