



CLEP

(aka College Level Exam Program®)

The College-Level Examination Program® or CLEP provides students of any age with the opportunity to demonstrate college-level achievement through a program of exams in undergraduate college courses. By receiving a satisfactory score, students can earn from 3 to 12 college credits toward a college degree for each CLEP exam taken, depending on the exam subject and the policy of the college or university.

- **Save time.** Get college credit for what you already know. Be rewarded for what you've learned through independent study, advanced high school courses, noncredit adult courses, or professional development.
- **Save money.** Compare the cost of a CLEP exam to hundreds - even thousands - of dollars in tuition. CLEP exams are free to military service members.
- **Make college more interesting.** Move right into advanced courses.
- CLEP is administered on computer and exams are **available year-round**.
- The tests are timed at a **max of 90 minutes** in length.
- The exam's raw score is converted to a scaled score that ranges from 20 to 80. The final scaled score is the score that appears on the score report.
- With the exception of English Composition with Essay, exams are composed primarily of multiple-choice questions. Some mathematics exams include fill-in type questions.
- Score reports are available immediately upon completion of the exam. (Scores for English Composition with Essay are available 2-3 weeks after the exam date).
- Scores can be sent to **one institution for free during registration**, or you can request an official CLEP transcript after exam day for a \$20 fee. Transcripts can be ordered by logging in to the CLEP My Account registration portal.

Requirements: CLEP exams are available by appointment only. You must register for your CLEP at www.clep.collegeboard.org/ prior to calling to set up an appointment with the Testing Center. Students will pay an \$89 test fee to CLEP online at clep.collegeboard.org and a \$35 proctor fee payable to the Testing Center at marketplace.tamuc.edu.

Appointments are scheduled Monday-Friday in the Testing Center and you must call to schedule your appointment at least 24 hrs. in advance (72 hrs. for Monday) of your desired test date and time. Examinees must present: **(1)** purchase the \$35 proctor fee on the marketplace and **(2)** present a valid (not expired) government or state issued photo ID with signature on testing day.
