ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Each applicant must first apply and meet general requirements of the Graduate School.

- 1. Applicants must hold a valid Texas teaching certificate (or) successful scores on the TExES
- exam (or) have a satisfactory score of the combined verbal and quantitative portions of the GRE. 2. Previous coursework (undergraduate or graduate) grade point average must be 2.75 overall
- or 2.75 on the last 60 hours.

DEGREE PLAN ADVISEMENT

This advising guide is not official. To access your official degree plan go to <u>https://leo.tamuc.edu/</u>, enter your campus ID & password, click myLeo, and click on "*DegreeWorks login for students*." *DegreeWorks (DW) records* your grades on classes completed and requirements yet to be completed. You and your advisor will use *DW* to track your progress and make advisor-approved changes in your plan.

MASTERS COMPREHENSIVE EXAM

Students are required to take and pass a written comprehensive examination during the semester they graduate. Exams are given three times a year; fall, spring, and summer 1. It is important to apply during the very first week of your final semester. To get more information about the exams and submit your application, click on Master's Comprehensive Exam Information and Application.

GRADUATION APPLICATION

Because the window to apply for graduation is extremely short, it is important to apply <u>during the first</u> <u>two weeks of the semester you plan to graduate</u>. Then update your degree plan and email it to your advisor who must have it to endorse your application for graduation.
