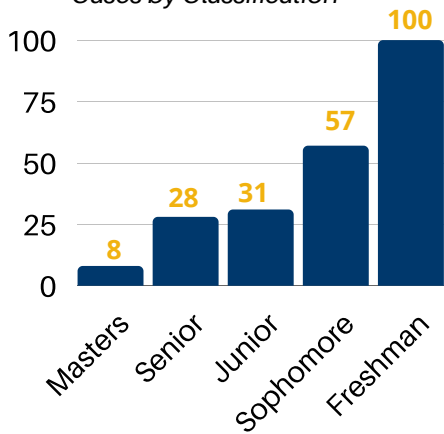
MISSION

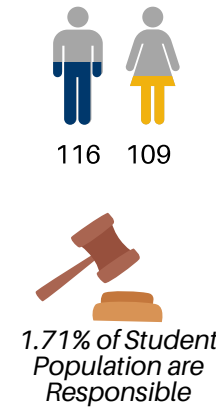

Cases by Classification



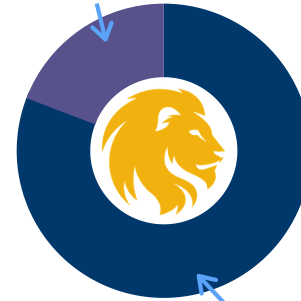
Cases by Gender

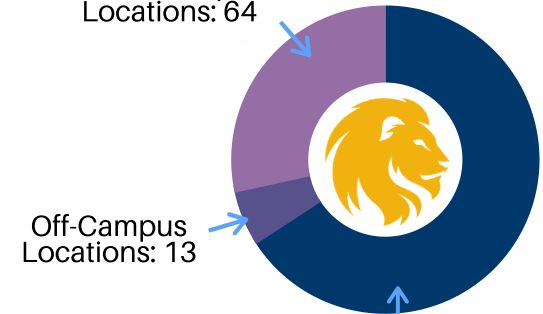
INCIDENT BY STUDENT & LOCATION TYPE

PANDEMIC RELATED VIOLATIONS

- ~ 25% of the violations were Code of Conduct: Failure to Comply
- 21 Community Standards: Mask in RLL
- 53 Community Standard: Guest & Visitation in RLL

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Launched BSCA initiative
- Implemented *Tip of the Month* in RLL newsletter & CLSS Social Media
- 29% decrease in the # of students found responsible
- 44% decrease in # of students responsible for substance abuse (marijuana & alcohol combined)

FUTURE PLANS

- Increase effectiveness of substance abuse education
- Host event during Lions Roar
- Expand the BSCA initiative to include more members and hearing types
