

Campus Recreation Student Advisory Board

The Campus Recreation Advisory Board shall serve in an advisory capacity to the Department of Campus Recreation. Its purpose is to receive student feedback and advice in the planning, organization, and administration of recreation programs, services, and facilities. The Campus Recreation Advisory Board will consist of six to ten students, selected by the Director of Campus Recreation and a member of SGA (Student Government Association). Board Members must be enrolled students (paying the Rec fee) and be in good standing with the University during their year on the Board.

Advisory Board Responsibilities:

- Serve as a sounding board for new and existing Campus Recreation programs and services
- Share with Campus Recreation the impact that new and existing policies/procedures have on students and how the student experience could be improved
- Advise Campus Recreation of needed additions and improvements to recreational facilities
- Advise Campus Recreation on any particular student concerns and how to reach those students who are not currently utilizing Campus Recreation programs and facilities.

Benefits of Serving on the Advisory Board:

- Free shirt and food provided at meetings
- Represent the student voice to improve Campus Recreation programs and services
- Invitation to the Campus Recreation Recspys an end of the year appreciation banquet for student employees and volunteers

Commitment Expectation for Serving on Advisory Board:

- One year commitment to serve on the advisory board (fall and spring semesters)
- Active participation in the four to six meetings during the academic year (No meetings in the summer)
- Occasionally surveying fellow students to receive broader feedback
- Helping to recruit new board members when your term is ending
