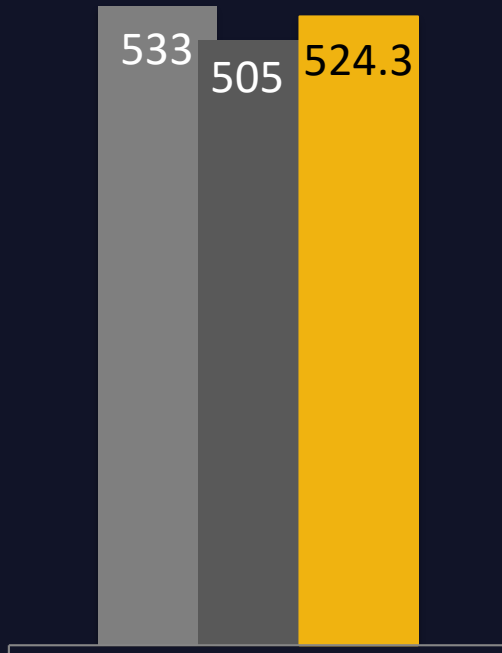

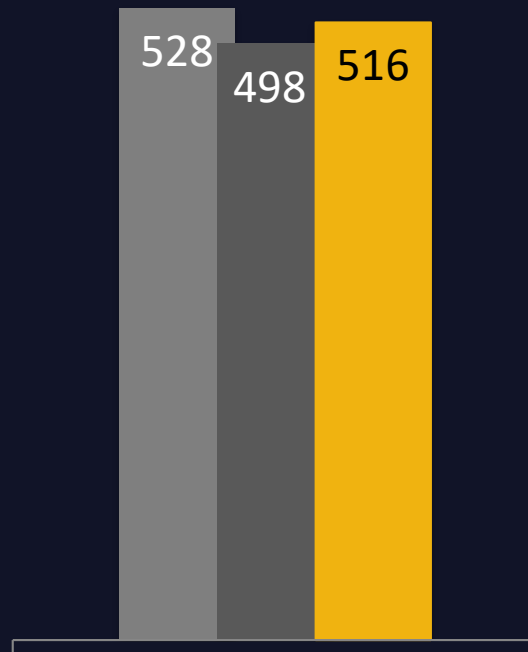
# SAT/ACT COMPARISON FOR ENROLLED STUDENTS

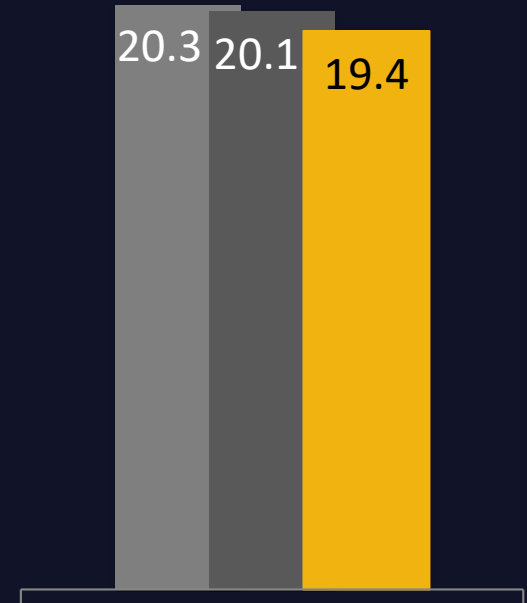
### SAT Evidence Based Reading and Writing

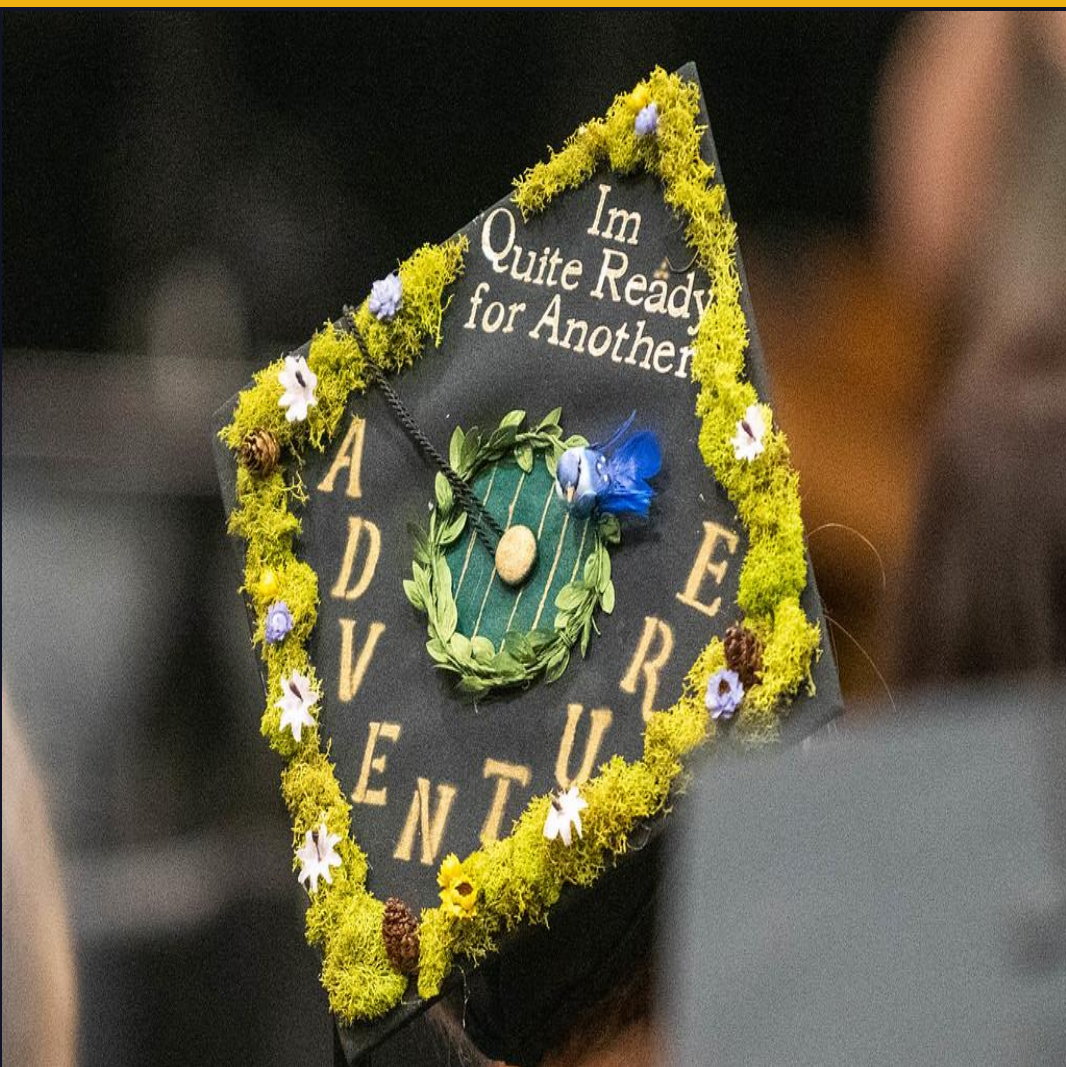

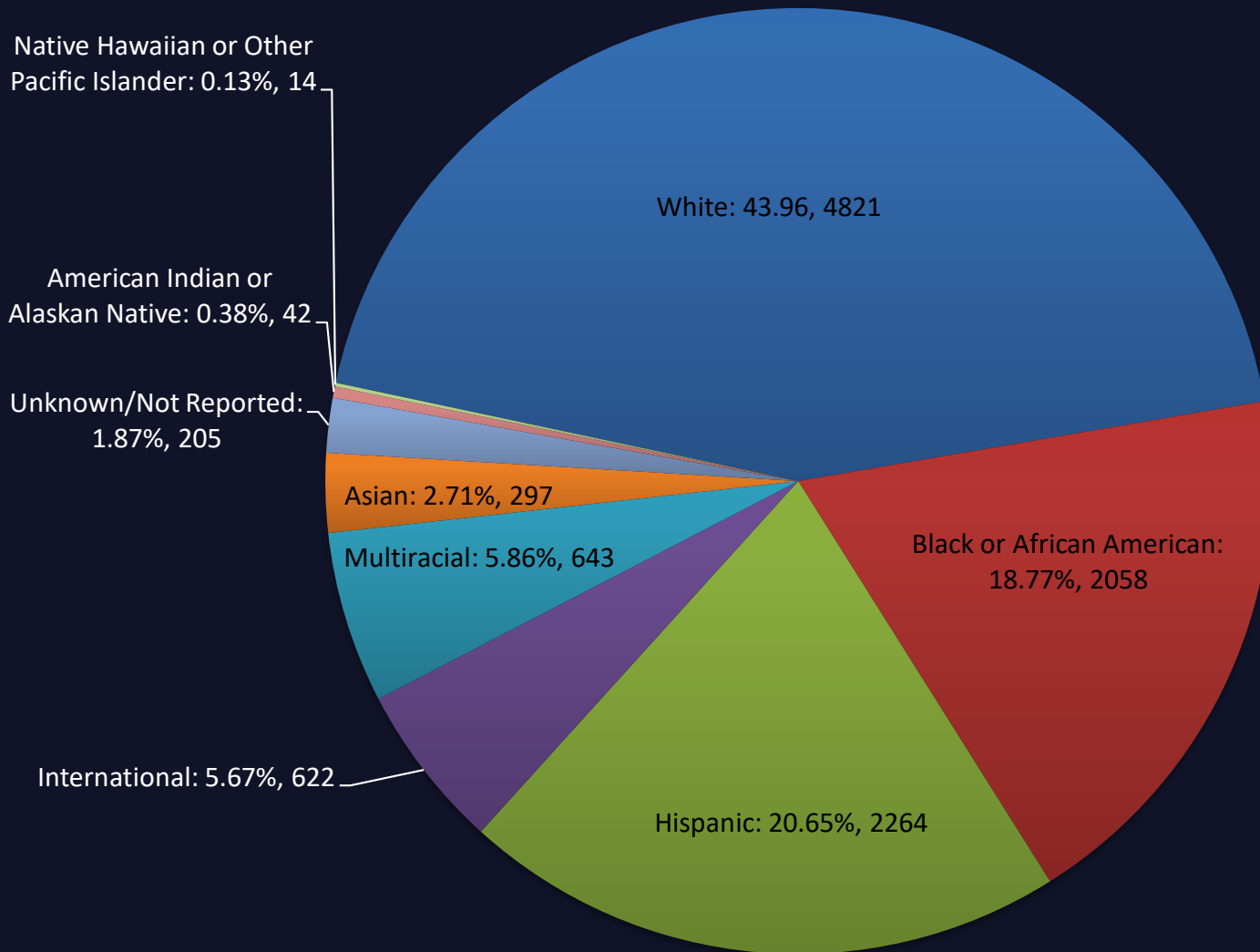

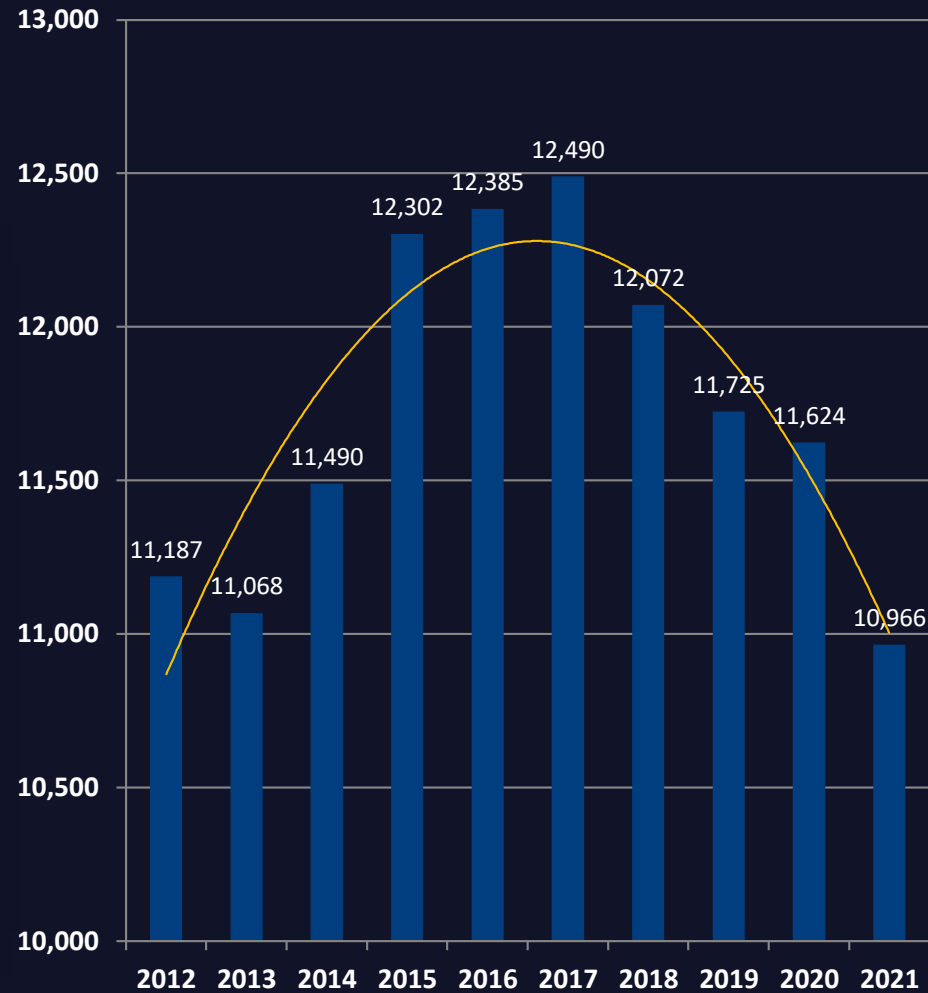

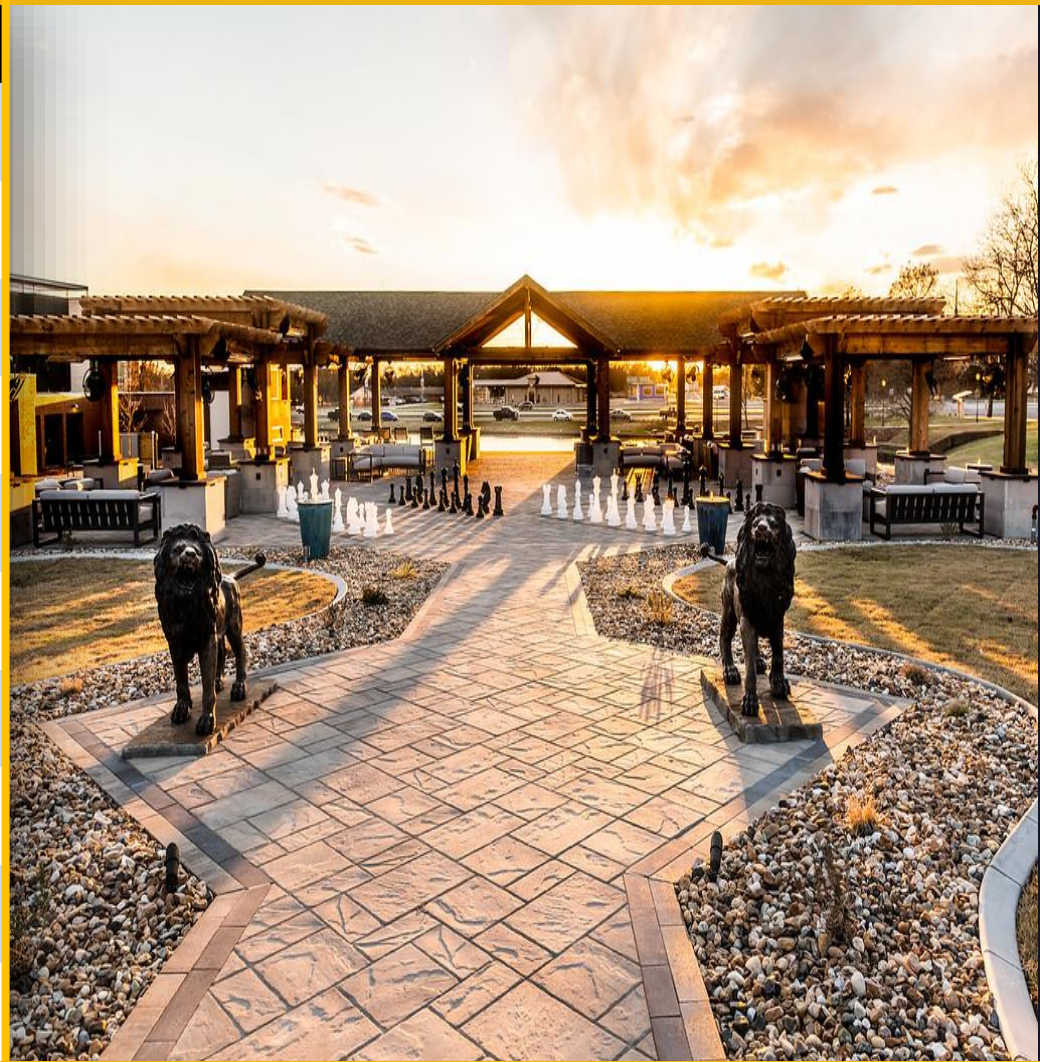



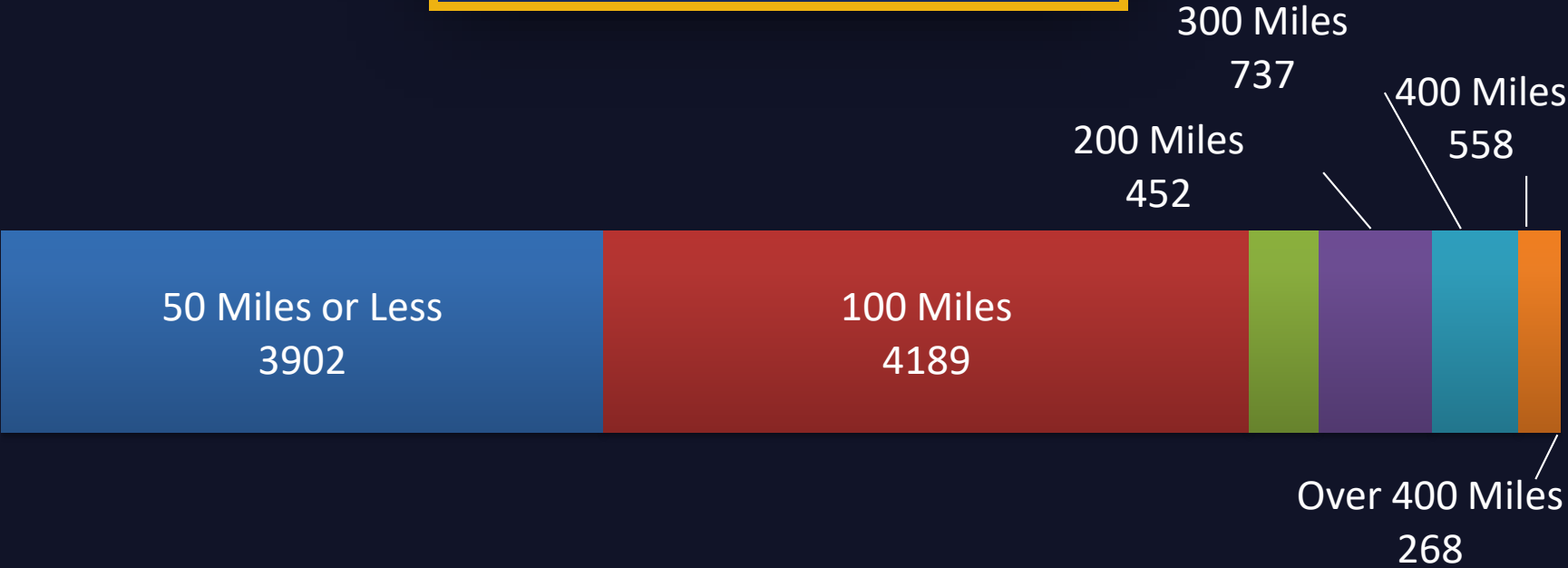

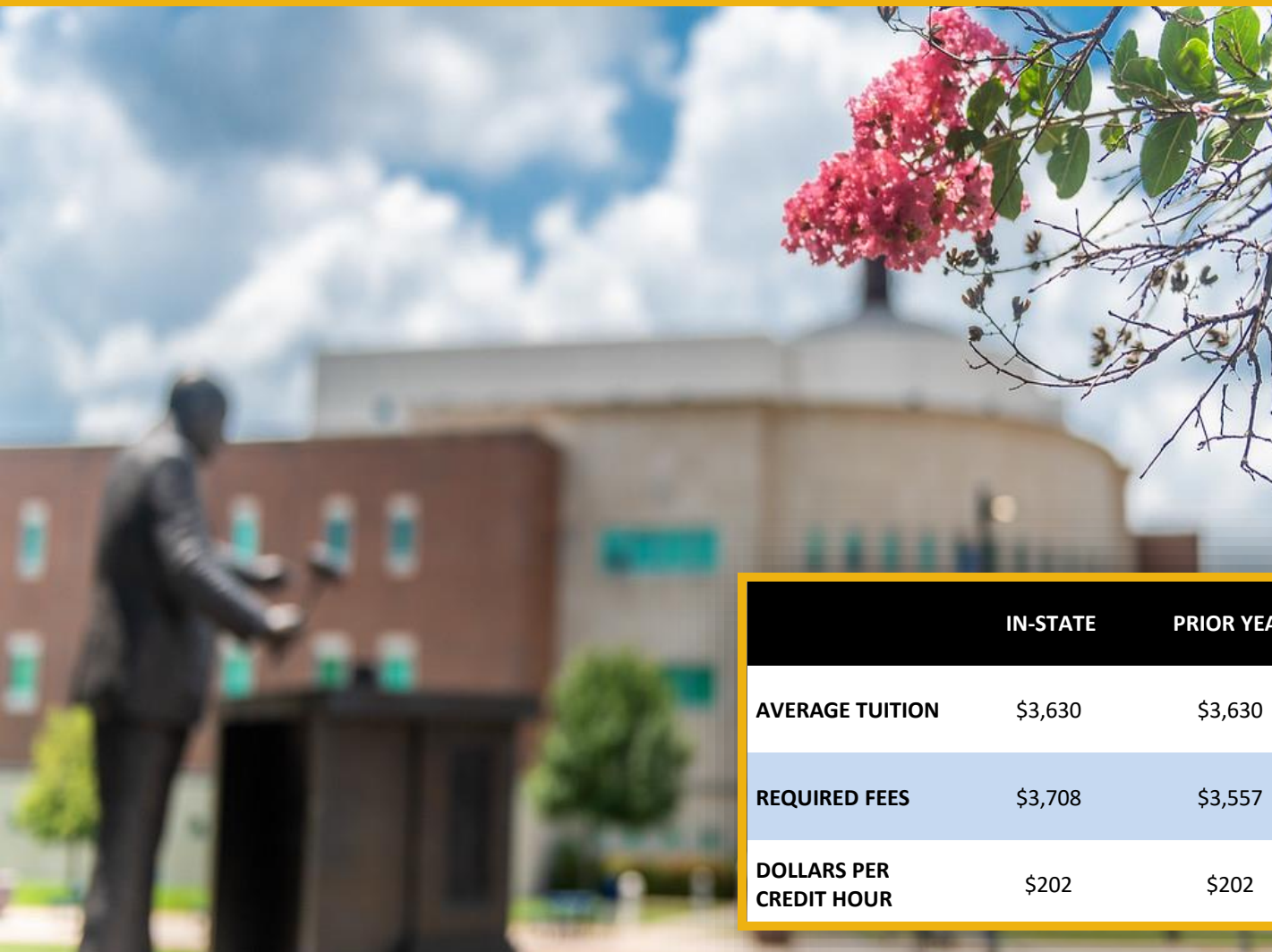
