- Always be courteous and helpful but refrain from initiating conversation with reviewers.
- Wear your A&M-Commerce name tag during the visit.
- Answer *only* the question(s) that is asked during your interview.
- Please do not guess or make assumptions during interviews; refer reviewers to Dr. Ricky Dobbs if needed.
- Remember, this is an all-hands on deck situation!
