Parking Lot Permits

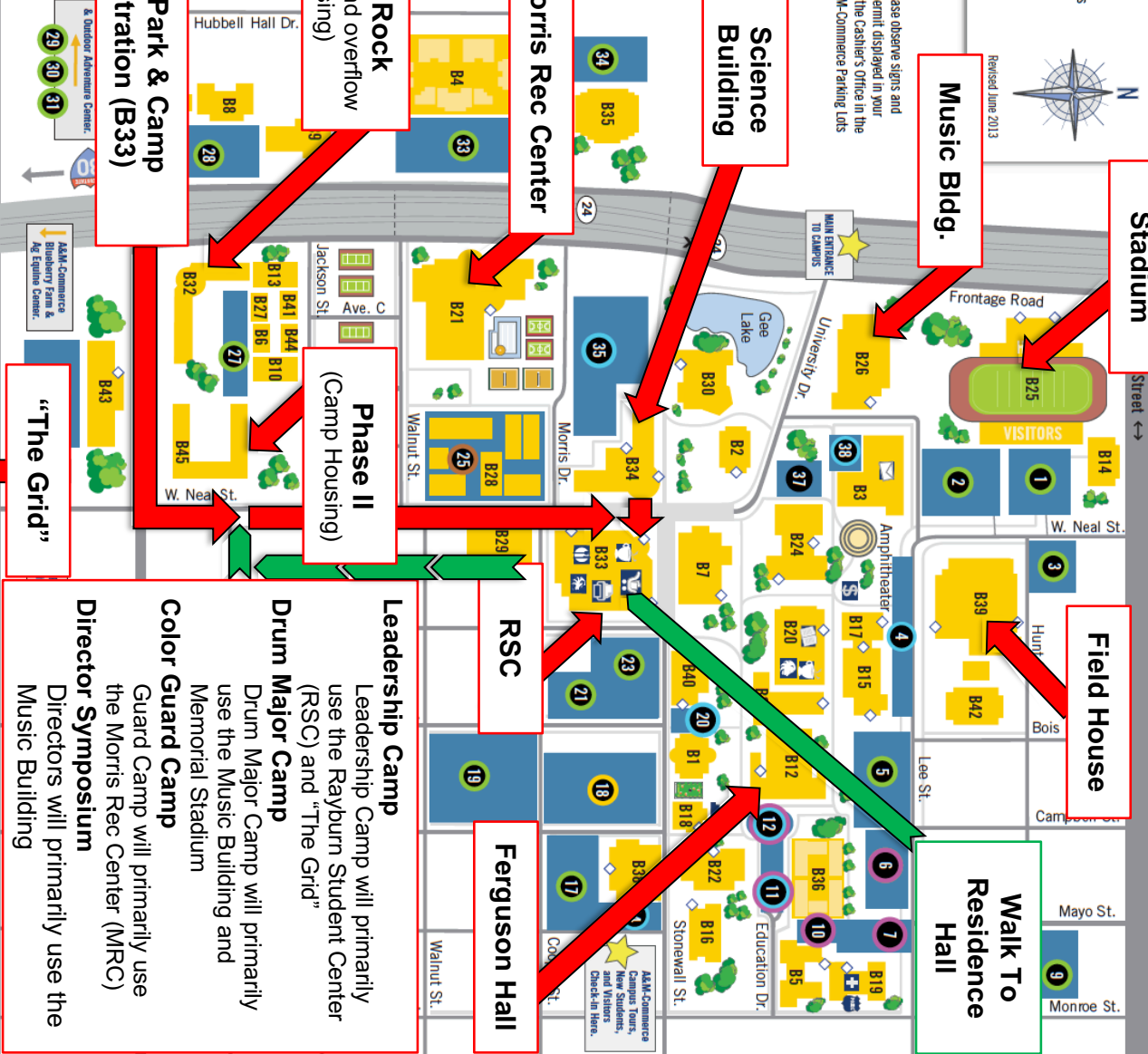
